ABOUT THE NEW ART WALL IN ASAP OFFICE (ROOM C-490)

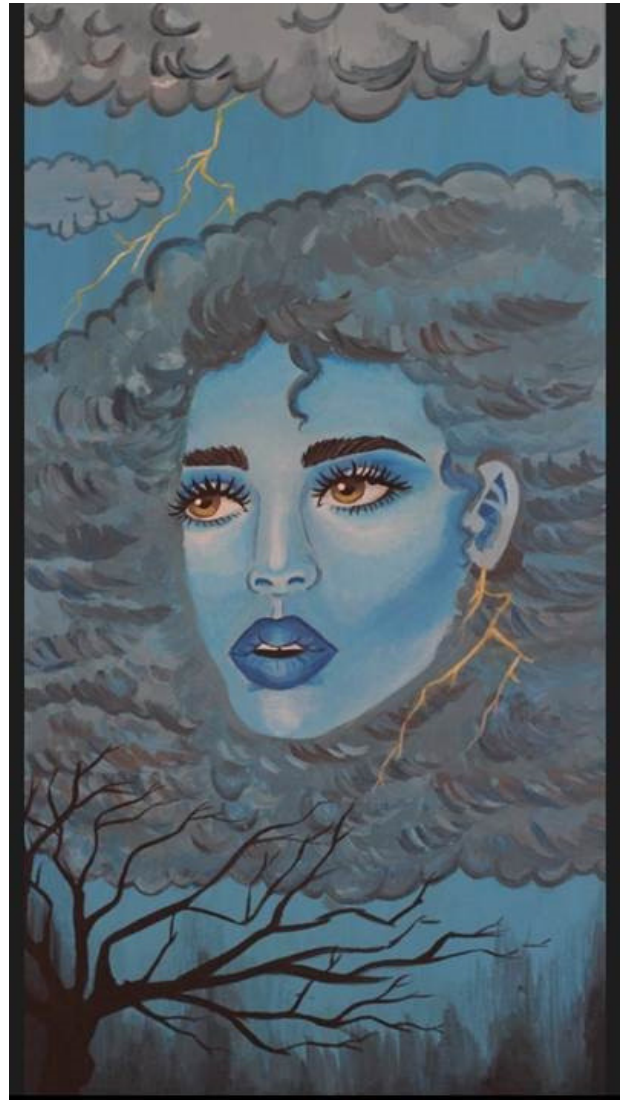
A gallery of ASAP students' artwork
